POSITION DESCRIPTION

Position: **Water and Wastewater Treatment Operator III**
Department: **Water/Wastewater Treatment**
Reports To: **Treatment Supervisor**

Position Summary:

This position performs the daily required activities at Water and Wastewater Treatment, associated tanks and structures, and affiliated water systems as required. Adjusts chemical feed rates, performs corrective and preventive maintenance, performs laboratory test, along with a variety of other tasks.

Essential Duties:

- Adjusts chemical feed rates
- Performs corrective and preventive maintenance
- Performs laboratory tests
- Makes routine checks on a variety of equipment and records information as required.
- Performs a variety of operational tasks, some of which include wasting, pumping, sampling, skimming, washing, etc.
- Performs analytical tests and calculations to insure proper process control of the treatment plant. Makes process control adjustments in response to lab results.
- Performs corrective and preventive maintenance on a variety of mechanical equipment.
- Maintains buildings and grounds as required.
- Records information and fills out reports.
- Performs other duties as assigned.
- Required to be “on call” as assigned and able to respond within thirty minutes.
- Must be able to work holidays, weekends and shift work as required.

Knowledge and Skills

- Must have a high school diploma or GED
- Must have a valid driver’s license
- Must have a basic knowledge of Water Treatment operations and maintenance
- Must have a basic knowledge of Wastewater Treatment operations and maintenance
- Must have a Class III Wastewater Operators License or the ability to obtain a Class III certification within 12 months from hire date.

Physical/Environmental Requirements

The environmental working conditions of this position will include working inside and outside in all types of weather with exposure to dust or fumes and poor ventilation. This position is frequently subjected to loud noise.
