

LAST CALL FOR HURRICANE MICHAEL DEBRIS PICK-UP

Updated: April 8, 2019

Hurricane Michael debris pick-up is in the final stages of completion. All storm related debris must be located in the City's right-of-ways or curbside before Friday, April 12, 2019 for free pick-up.

Hurricane vegetative debris is required to be maintained in a separate pile and piles located on private property will not be removed. This is the last opportunity for free hurricane debris removal.

Normal and routine city pick-up of yard trimmings is ongoing and not part of the hurricane debris removal effort. **DO NOT** combine normal yard trimmings or other material with hurricane debris. Contractors **WILL NOT** remove piles with co-mingled debris.
